Principles of participation:

1. Advertising stickers, flags and other things inappropriate to the era of the vehicle's manufacturing are not allowed. As an exception, you can use period accessories or tuning, club's insignia/flags and Balti Kett 35 driving insignia.
2. All participating vehicles comply with traffic regulations, including speed limit, right of way, etc. Deviation from the right-of-way requirements is permitted only based on a clear notice from the regulator.
3. When driving on the road, ordinary motorists must be allowed to overtake, including allowing to line up between the columns.
4. All times are given according to the first car in the convoy - this is necessary for the spectators to know when the convoy will arrive.
5. The sound signal is used as little as possible so as not to disturb ordinary people.
6. Cars with the flags of three Baltic countries drive in front of the column - the first is the flag car of the home country. The order of flag cars is changed at the national border, the car that takes over the role of the leading car in the next country drives as the second car (Latvia in Estonia, Lithuania in Latvia and Estonia in Lithuania).
7. The speed of the first car does not exceed 60 km/h and, in general, it is not driven below 30 km/h (to ensure the safety and cooling of motorcycles). To stay on schedule, the first car may make short stops at safe locations to adjust the time of arrival at the next location and allow the rear of the column to catch up.
8. Cars with three flags drive in front of the column, followed by motorcycles, cars, buses and trucks (in such order). In each group of vehicles, if possible, older vehicles are driven first in the order of age. Modern escort cars drive at the end, not in the middle of the column.
9. As a general rule, overtaking (passing) is not done when moving in a column, it is recommended that overtaking is done only in situations where the driver of the vehicle in front gives a clear signal.
10. The schedule is strictly adhered to. As a general rule, you do not leave the exhibition place before the scheduled time. If there is a need for this, then stop before the exhibition site to choose a place where it is possible to leave without disturbing others.

The participation fee is 100 euros per vehicle (including the driver), 60 euros per passenger, 8- to 17-year-old children 30 euros, children up to the age of 7 are free .

The participation fee includes – the materials of the tour, exhibitions, light lunches on four days, information about accommodation (free camping possibilities), guarded parking at nights, technical support during the whole tour. The participation fee does not include – breakfasts, dinners, accommodation, after-party. **The fee of the after party is 40 euros per person, children up to the age of 7 are free.** The fee includes the party, dinner, program. All lovers of unique cars are welcome to take part of the after party, even if they did not take part of the tour. The registration is necessary.
